In the light of His glory and grace.*

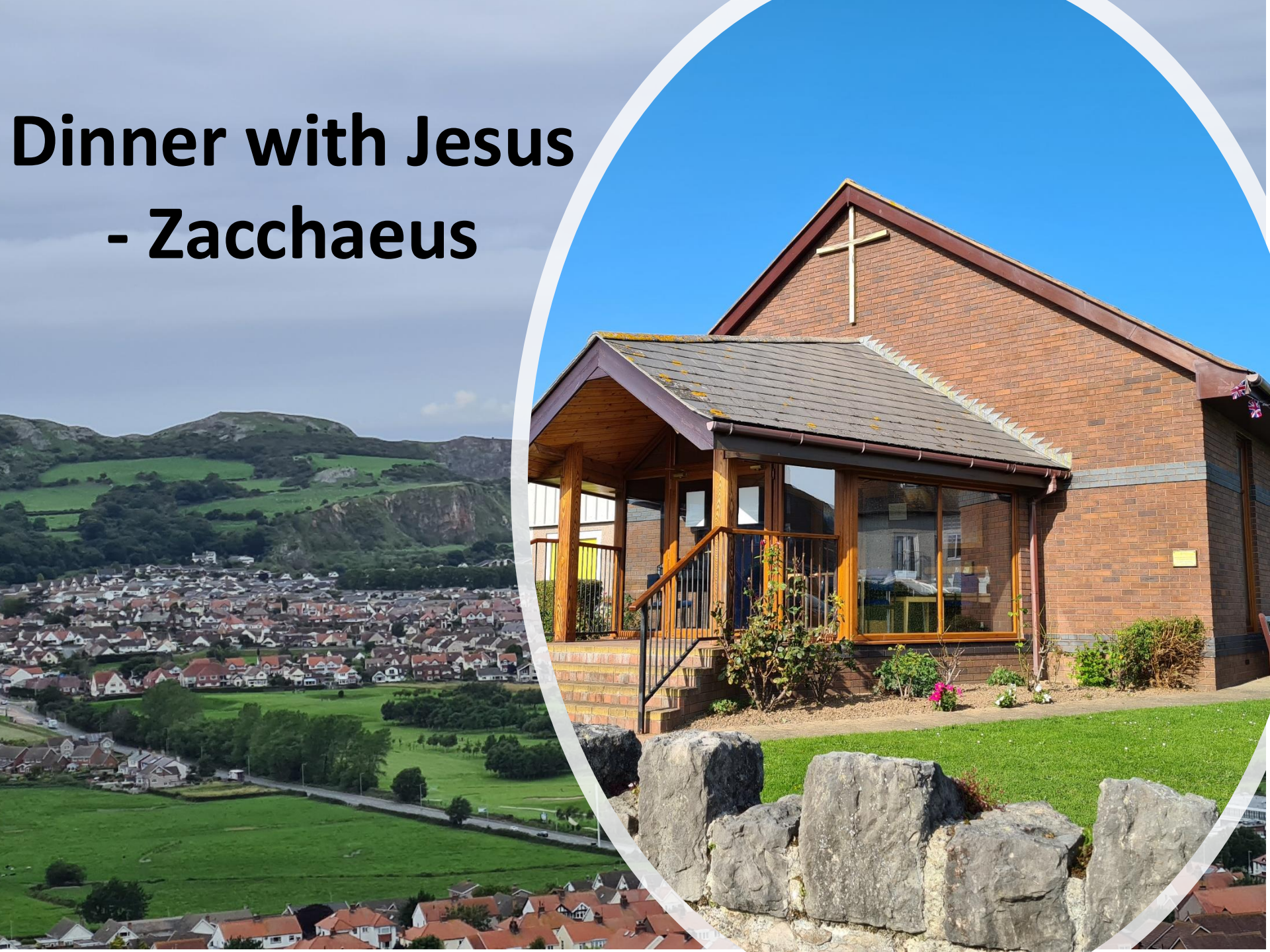

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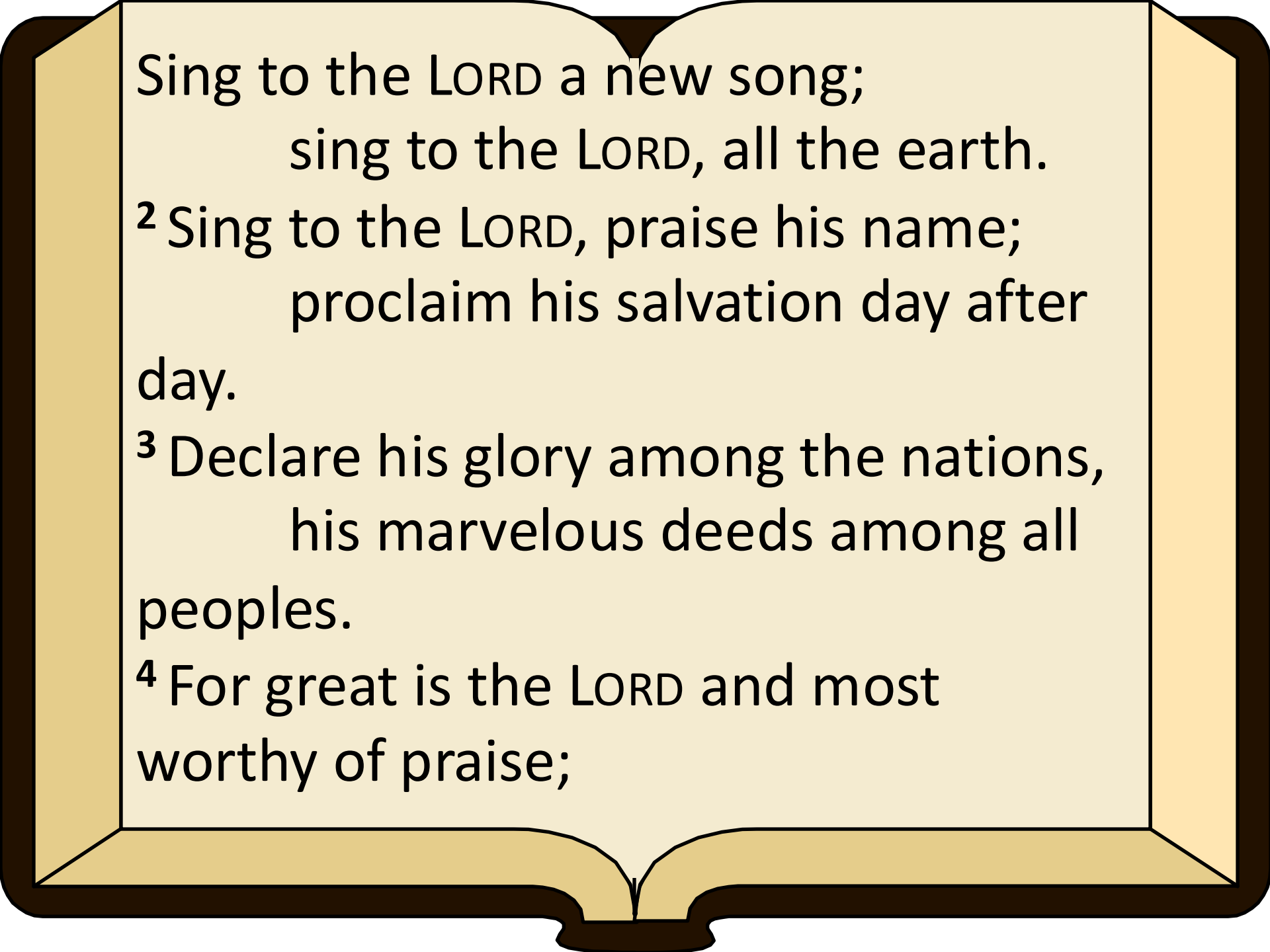

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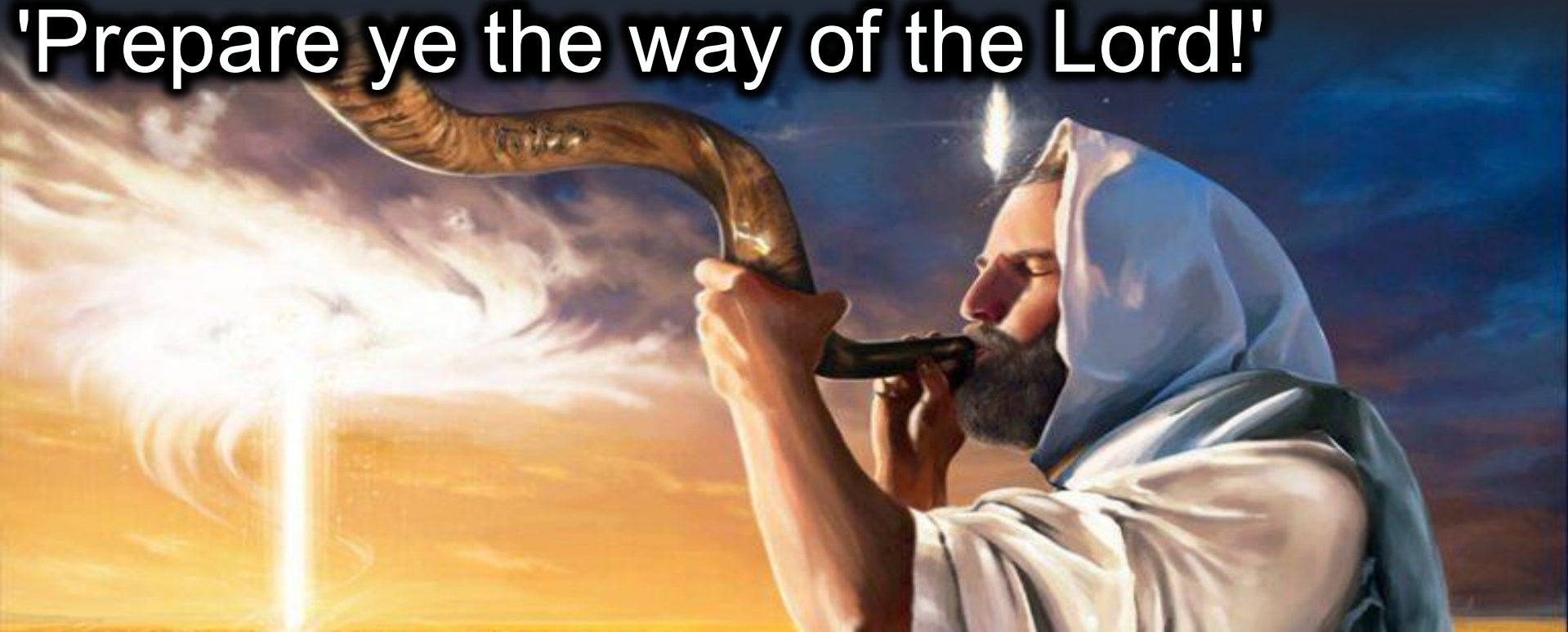

Out of Zion's hill salvation comes.*







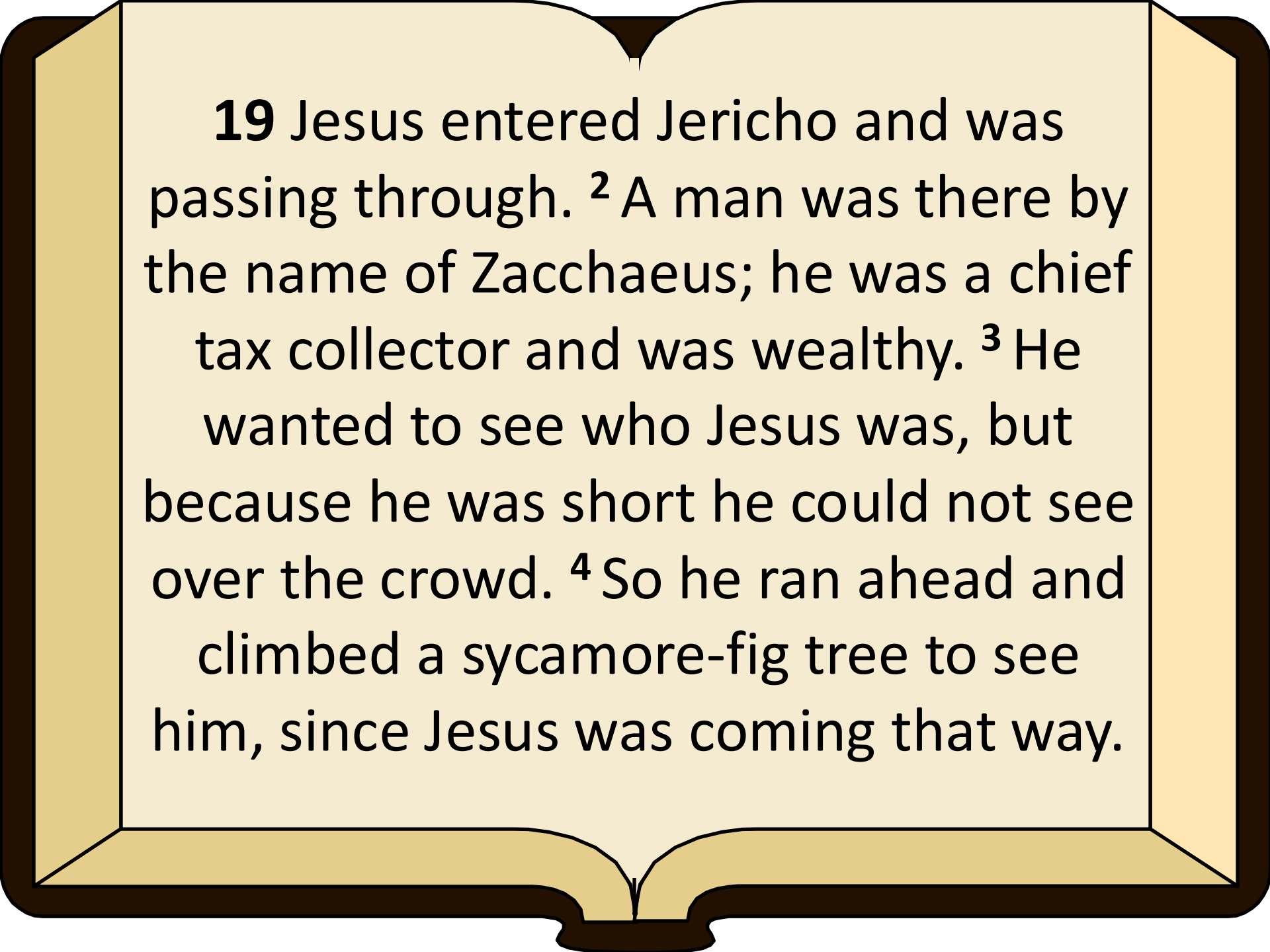

verses 1-10

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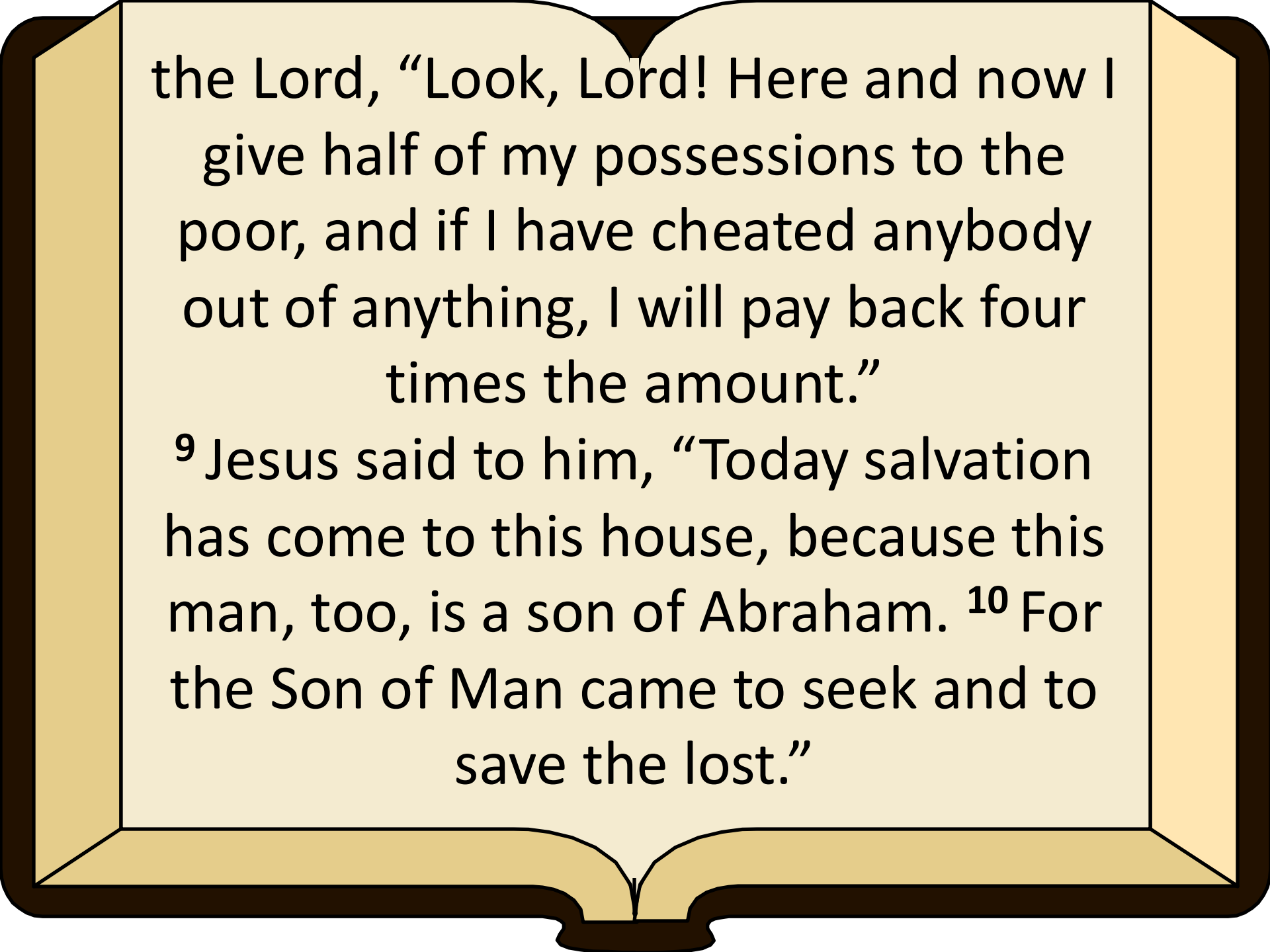

and boundless peace



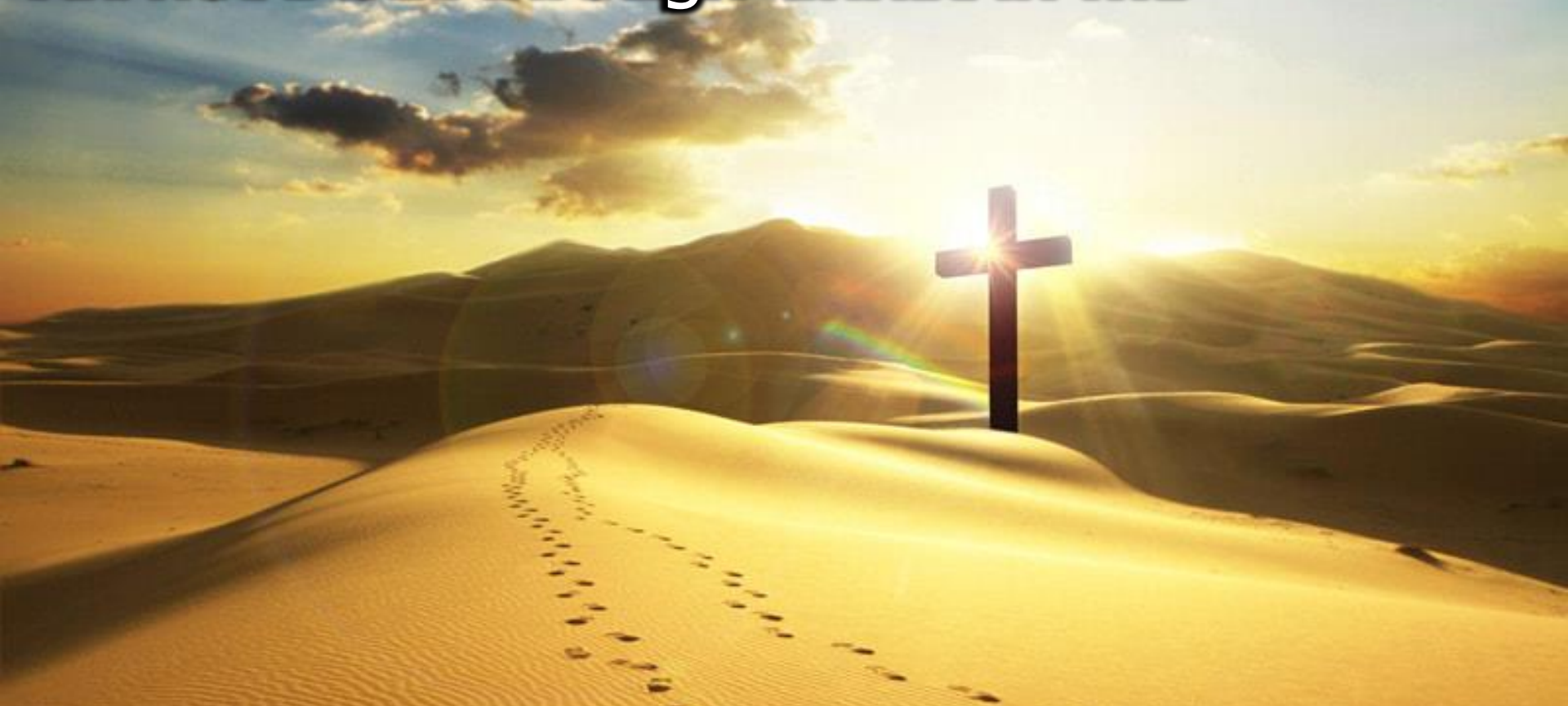
To this I hold, my hope is only Jesus

Yet not I but through Christ in me



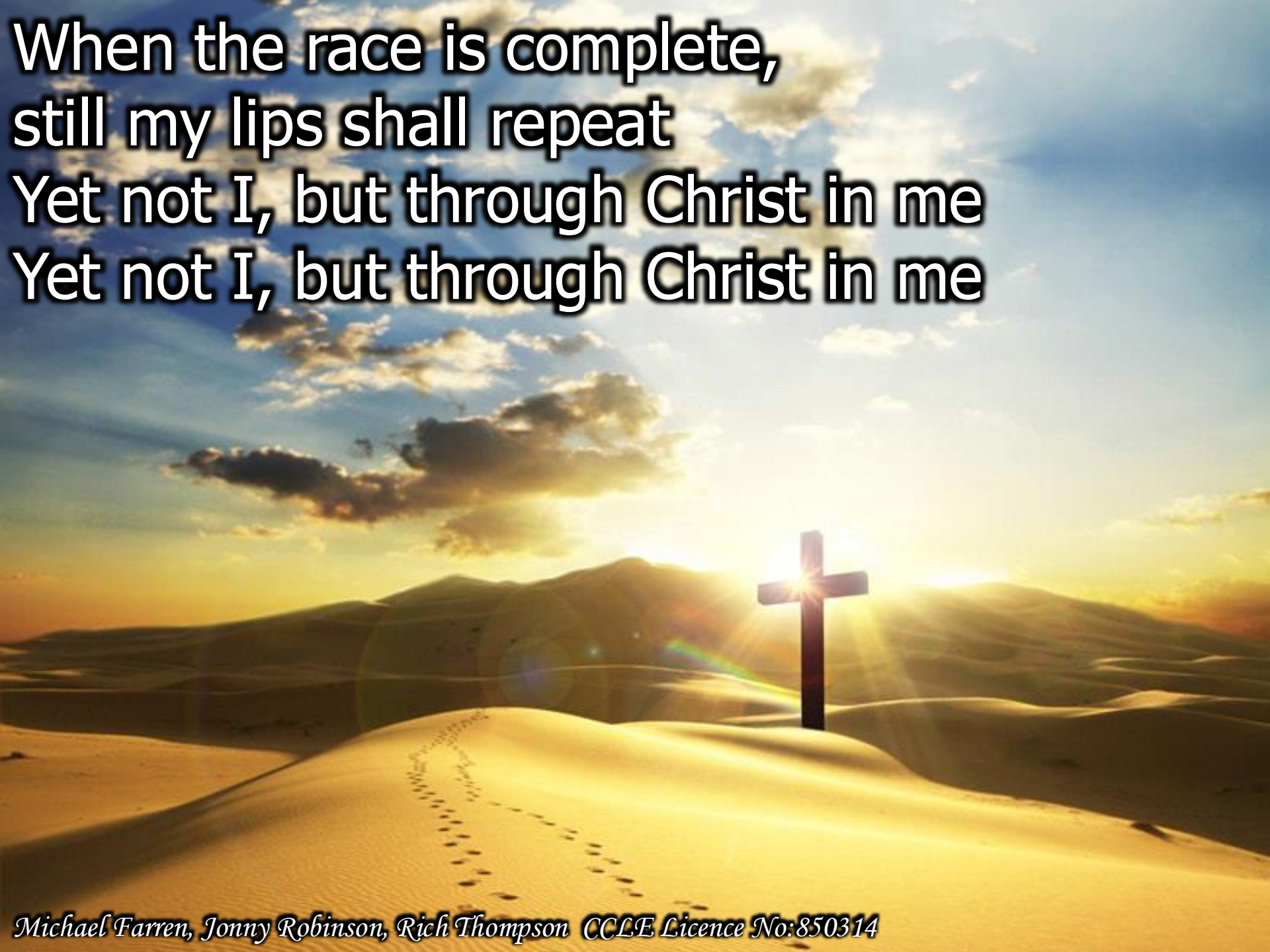
With every breath I long to follow Jesus
